

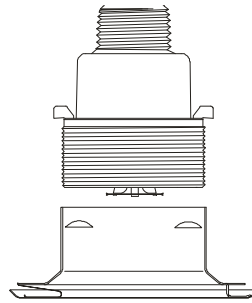

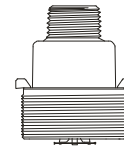

Concealed Pendent Sprinkler**

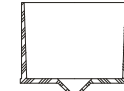
**Sprinkler:** Base Part Number 10784A



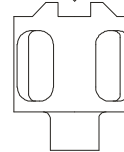
**Cover Plate Assembly:**

**GENERAL HANDLING AND STORAGE INSTRUCTIONS:**

- Do not store in temperatures exceeding 100 °F (38 °C). Avoid direct sunlight and confined areas subject to heat.
- Protect sprinklers and cover assemblies during storage, transport, handling, and after installation.
  - Use original shipping containers.
  - Do not place sprinklers or cover assemblies loose in boxes, bins, or buckets.
- Keep the sprinkler bodies covered with the protective sprinkler cap (Viking Part Number 08991) during installation, testing, and any time the sprinklers are handled or shipped.
- Use one of the special wrenches (Viking Part Numbers 08336W/B or 10366W/B) designed for installing Freedom™ Residential Concealed Sprinklers.
- Do not over-tighten the sprinklers into fittings during installation.
- Do not use the fusible link to start or thread the sprinklers into fittings during installation.
- Do not attempt to remove drywall, paint, etc., from the sprinklers.
