

FLOW in GPM (C=100)

Friction Loss for the 4" Model VXR Dry Valve is equivalent to 21 feet of 4" Schedule 40 (I.D.= 4.029") pipe (C=100).

To calculate friction loss for the 4" (I.D. = 4.029") Viking Model VXR Dry Valve at a specific flow, use the following formula:

P = Friction Loss (PSI) Q= Flow (GPM) C = Constant (=100)

$$P_{PSI} = \left(\frac{4.52 \times Q^{1.85}}{C^{1.85} \times 4.029^{4.87}} \right) \times 21$$
